Who is the role suitable for?

- Someone with an interest in reducing waste
- Someone who is honest and reliable
- Someone who is comfortable meeting and speaking with new people
- Someone over 25 with a clean driving licence
- Someone who is physically able to lift and carry boxes



Extra Information:

Time Commitment: This will vary and can be agreed with the Store Manager prior to starting.

Training: All volunteers will receive a full induction and training for the role, including training in First Aid and Manual Handling.

Support: All volunteers will receive ongoing support with regular one-to-one meetings with the volunteering co-ordinator. A member of staff will be contactable at all times whilst volunteering. Volunteers will be able to attend social events with other Foothold Cymru volunteers.

Expenses: Travel costs will be reimbursed. Lunch expenses for all-day volunteering can be reimbursed up to the value of £3.60.
