# KID'S TOY AND CLOTHING EXCHANGE: FAQs

## Q. What is a Kids Toy and Clothing Exchange?

A. It's an event where parents and caregivers can bring gently used toys and clothing their children no longer need and exchange them for other pre-loved items. It's a great way to refresh your child's wardrobe and toy collection without spending money.

## Q. When can I drop off items to exchange?

Bring in up to 10 items between 9.30am and 3pm on Monday 4th November.

## Q. What kind of items can I bring?

A. You can bring gently used toys and clothing suitable for children up to the age of 10 years. Please ensure that all items are clean, functional, and free from damage. We do not accept items that are broken, stained, or excessively worn.

## Q. Can I bring baby items?

A. Yes, baby items such as clothes, toys, and small equipment (e.g. baby carriers, nappy bags) are welcome, provided they meet safety standards and are in good condition.

## Q. How many items can I take home?

A. The number of items you can take home depends on the number of tokens or credits you receive when you bring in your items. For example, if you gave 5 items to exchange, you will receive 5 tokens to 'pay' for 5 items.

## Q. What happens to leftover items?

A. Any leftover items at the end of the exchange will be given to our permanent clothing exchange to support local families or given to an appropriate local organisation. This ensures that nothing goes to waste and helps the community.

## Q. Is there a cost to participate?

A. No, just up to 10 items that you'd like to donate.

## Q. Why should I participate in a Kids Toy and Clothing Exchange?

A. Participating in an exchange is an excellent way to save money, reduce waste, and promote a circular economy. It allows you to declutter your home, provide your child with new-to-them items, and connect with other families in your community.

Day of exchange: Thursday 7th November, 9.30 am - 11 am
